



**Tickets** - Fans can purchase their tickets on site by paying Cash or Card. Tickets for the event are **\$30 plus fees**. Ages 5 and under are free. Senior and active military can purchase discounted tickets at the door with a valid ID. **Parking** – There are multiple parking lots located at the venue. Parking fees vary by where you park. We do not control the cost for parking at the lots.

**Coaches Check In** - Each coach will need to individually report to Coaches Check in to receive their coaches badges. Coaches check in will begin at 7:30AM in the coaches lounge. If you are a USASF member you can show your USASF credentials. If you are not a USASF member you will need to show an approved background check. If any coach has not completed a background check, the gym director must sign a form stating that all due diligence was done prior to hiring their coaches. For a program to receive any credentials the program must be paid in full with all waivers and rosters submitted. Anyone entering the warmup area must have our new coaches badge and coaches arm band.

**Cheer Warmups** – The warmup area is located behind the main performance area. Only coaches and athletes who receive their credentials may enter this area. Each team will have 5 minutes at the following stations - Stretch (3 Mats), Spring Tumble Strip (60 ft), Stunt mat & Nine (9) panel non spring floor with music. You will see your scheduled warm up time on the schedule. Please report 30 minutes before competition time. First station will be for team photos. Your warmup time will begin exactly 25 minutes prior to compete time. Make sure you are in warm up area 35 minutes prior to compete time.

**Competition Venue**– The competition venue is conveniently located in the **Bob Carpenter Center** on the first floor. We will also have VIP viewing section for the spectators of the teams taking the stage so you will have a perfect view!

**Scoring/Scoresheets** - Scoresheets will be EMAILED to the contact on your RegChamp account following the completion of each division. If you do not receive your scoresheets within 15 minutes of the completion of your division, please email [scoring@libertyspiritchampionships.com](mailto:scoring@libertyspiritchampionships.com) to notify us.

**Scoring Range Challenges** - You will have 15 minutes from the time the team's scoresheets are sent to submit any range or deduction challenges. All challenges will be submitted online at the following link. Once submitted, the head judge will review and contact you via email/text with final ruling within minutes. We have used this at multiple different events, and this is the most streamlined and efficient method we have witnessed.
